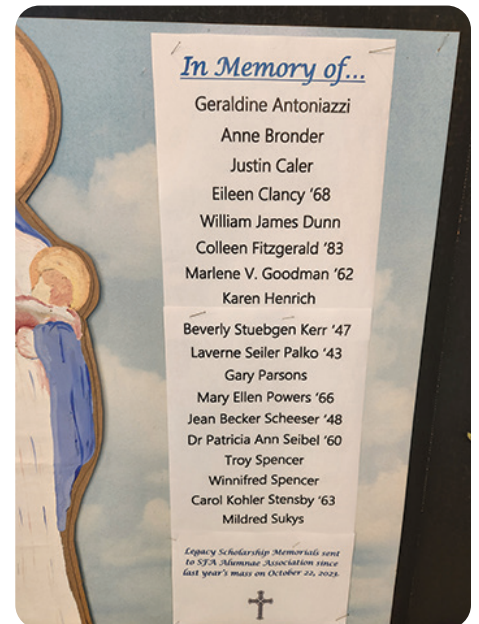


# ALUMNAE MEMORIAL MASS
