A lot can happen in twelve years. An education spanning twelve years at St. Francis Academy is something quite unique. The fond memories shared by Mary Friend Hirsh, Class of '56, imparts a story of the history

of St. Francis Academy. Beginning in 1944 through 1956, Mary made friends and continued those friendships throughout the years. After graduation, Mary was employed as a secretary for the Traffic Manager of the Hagan Corporation, which later became Calgon. As part of her job, travel arrangements were then a complex combination of handwritten tickets and numerous calls. The use of the word complex shows the valued skills that one needed in a time prior to computers and the internet. What takes us seconds to achieve now, took hours of preparation in the 50's, 60s and beginning of the 70s. Mary was quite adept at handling all the intricacies involved in her work. What was once called secretarial is now considered an administrative position that was learned with on-the-job training. Mary began a new job with the Mt. Lebanon High School in 1990 in the Guidance Department spanning fifteen years. Prior to the pandemic, Mary was a member of a prayer group which started with St. Germaine's Parish and spread to all the parishes in Our Lady of Hope. This group provided support to grieving families through a short prayer service at funeral homes. Mary also worked at the Franciscan Day Care Center. While working, as was often the case for that era, Mary raised five children, two girls and three boys. Mary embodies everything that St. Francis Academy inspired in all of us. All that we do with our work ethic, strength and our service to community, that was instilled in us by our parents and the Sisters of St. Francis of the Providence of God, will continue for generations.
